The Most Number of Waterfalls in Japan

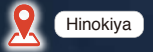
With over 200 waterfalls, enjoy touring several waterfalls when you first come to Hida-Osaka.

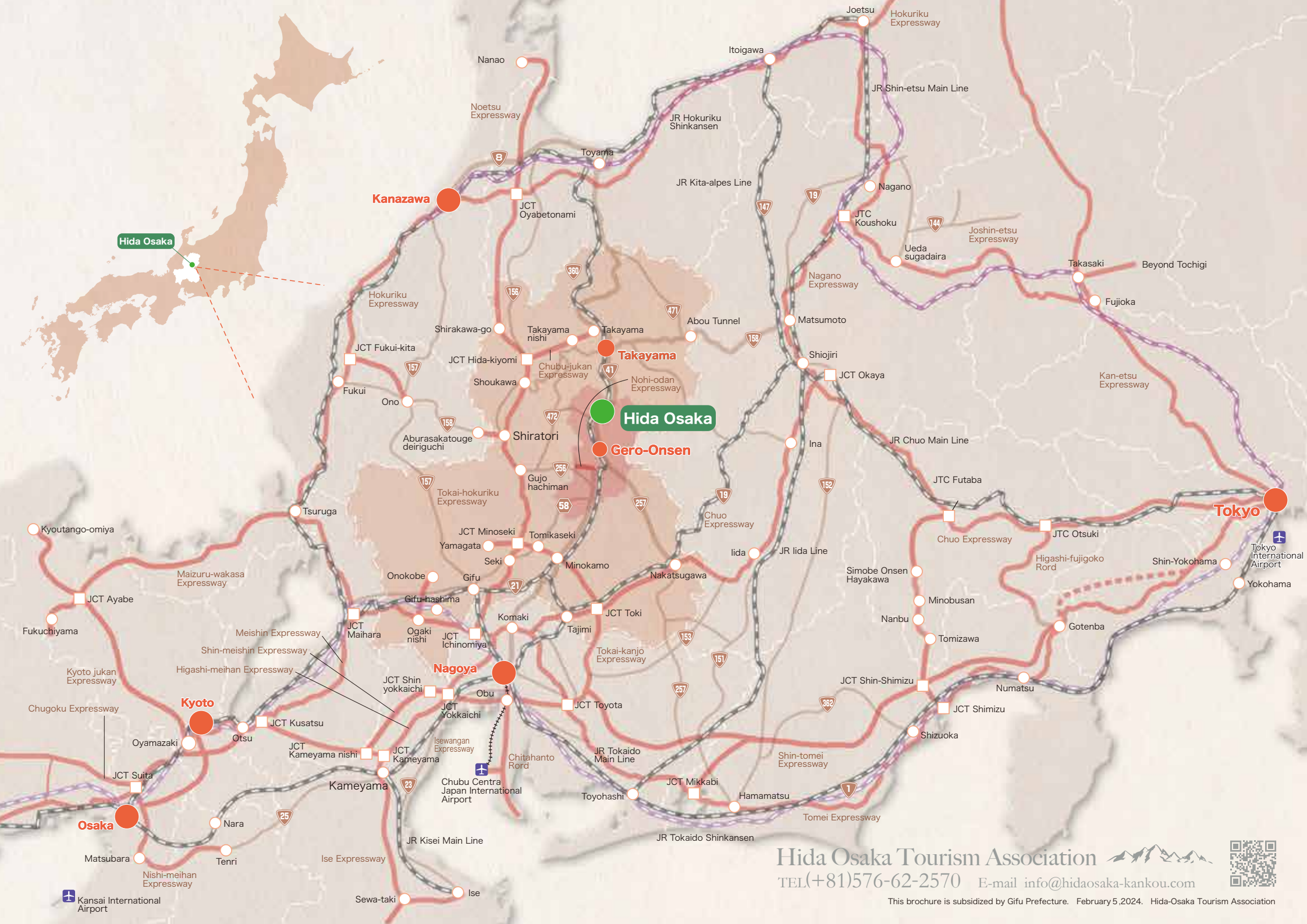
