Hida Osaka Waterfall Tour Map

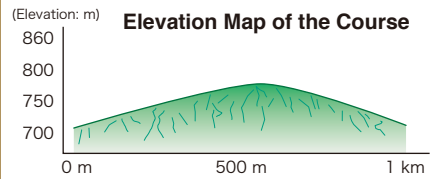


Donbiki Daira

It hosts clusters of rare plants, showcasing different expressions with each season.

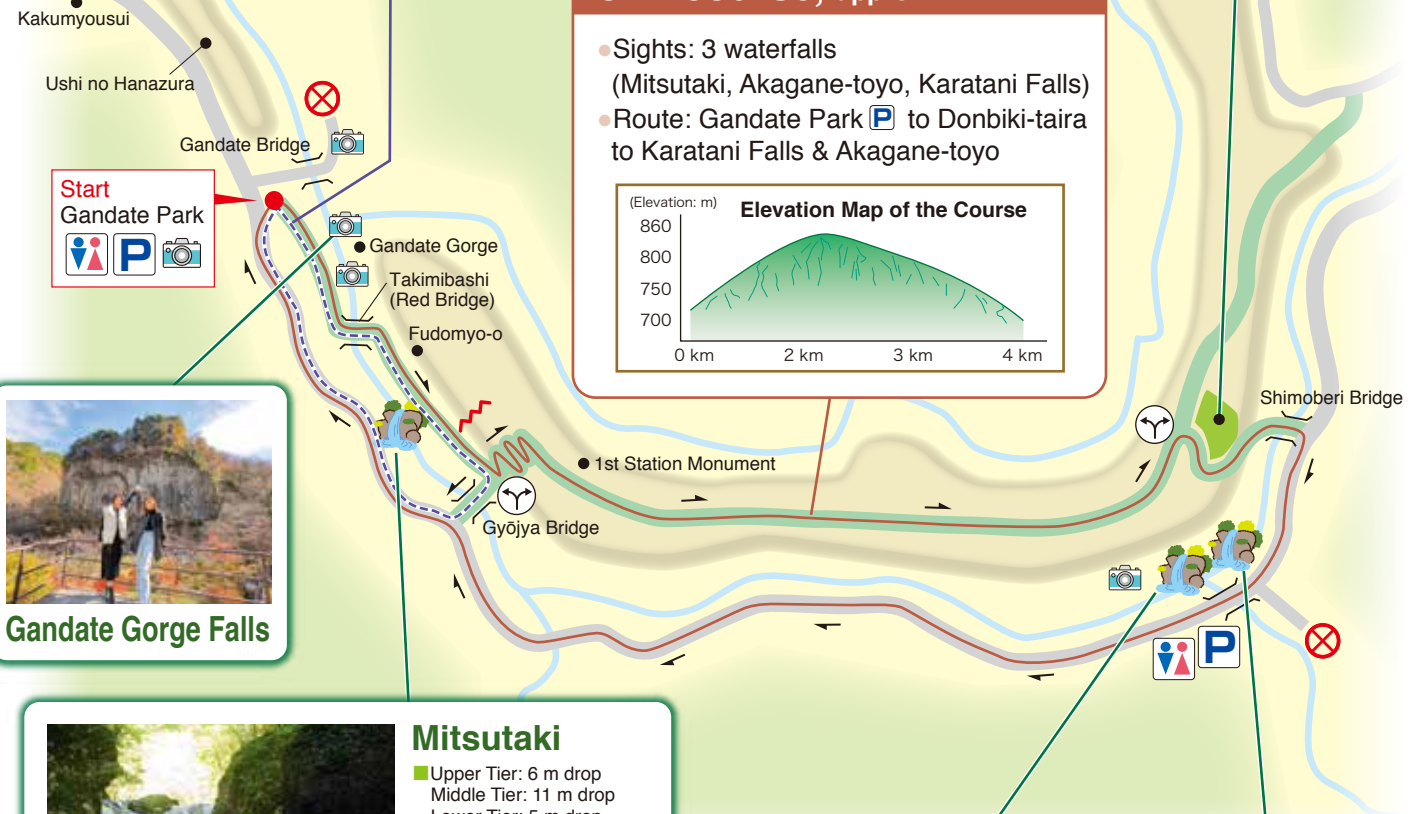
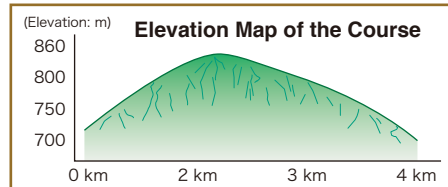
30 min. course, approx.1 km

- Sights: 1 waterfall (Mitsutaki)
- Route: Gandate Park to Gyōjya Bridge (with stairs)



3 hr course, approx.4 km

- Sights: 3 waterfalls (Mitsutaki, Akagane-toyo, Karatani Falls)
- Route: Gandate Park to Donbiki-taira to Karatani Falls & Akagane-toyo



Gandate Gorge Falls



Mitsutaki

- Upper Tier: 6 m drop
- Middle Tier: 11 m drop
- Lower Tier: 5 m drop

From Gandate Park, a 10-minute walk along the Takimi promenade reveals the impressive lower, middle, and upper tiers of the falls.



Akagane-toyo

- Drop: 14 m

"Akagane" means copper, and "toyo" means rain gutter. The waterfall is characterized by its shape resembling a rain gutter and its clear blue basin.



Karatani Falls ■ Drop: 15 m

The basin is covered by a dome shape, amplifying the sound and creating a powerful waterfall experience.
